

APPENDIX A - ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND CREDIT OUTCOMES

1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1.1 English language proficiency required

International students applying for admission into undergraduate courses are generally expected to demonstrate a level of English language proficiency that is equivalent to:

- IELTS – an overall band of 6, with no band less than 6
- TOEFL (Internet) – a test score of 80, with no section score less than 20
- TOEFL (Computer) – a test score of 213, with Essay Rating (ER) of 5

1.2 Result/grades required

Graduates are required to have successfully completed SIB 50110 Diploma of Beauty Therapy.

1.3 Other admission requirements (e.g. Working with Children Check)
